Wherever we are on our journey, we pray for more of your spirit, more of your joy, more of your peace and realisation of your unconditional grace. Help us to keep our eyes fixed on you throughout the year.

Sunday - Lord, we lift to you the preparations for the February half term holiday club. Inspire and energise the team with your Holy Spirit. Place your love on those who may attend, and we pray for open hearts and ears to hear your Word.
